

SETTING UP A TEAM FUNDRAISER TO BENEFIT SECOND HARVEST

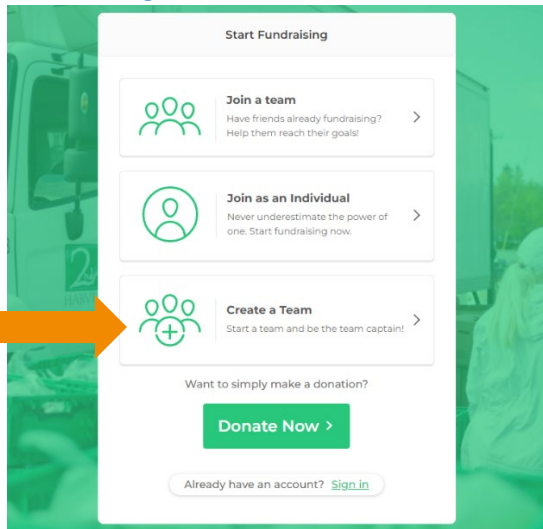
STEP 1: GET STARTED

Click the “start fundraising” button to begin your campaign.



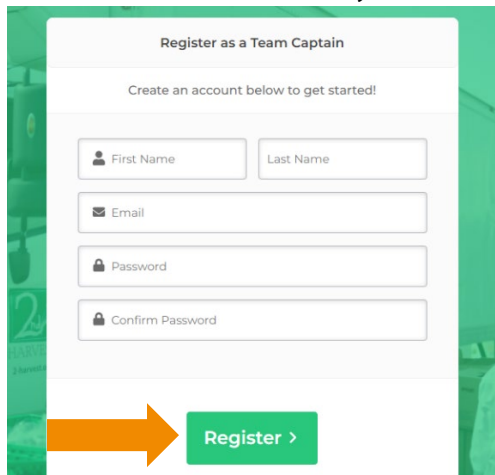
STEP 2: CHOOSE YOUR FUNDRAISER TYPE

STEP 3: CREATE YOUR ACCOUNT

Create an account to start your fundraiser. Fill out the requested information and click “Register”.



STEP 4: CREATE YOUR TEAM'S PROFILE

Create your team's fundraising profile. Create a team name and story, upload a team profile image and set your team's fundraising goal. The goal is automatically set at \$5,000, but you can raise or lower it to fit your needs. Choose if you want this team to be public or closed. You can also invite team members by email. Once this information is ready, click "Create Profile".




