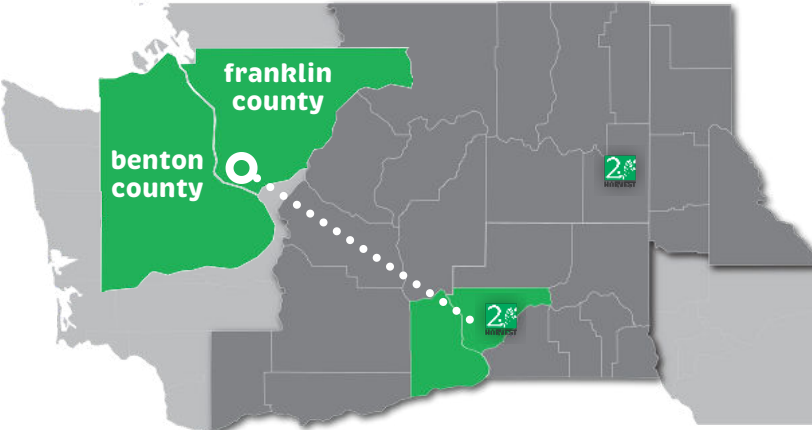
## how you help
