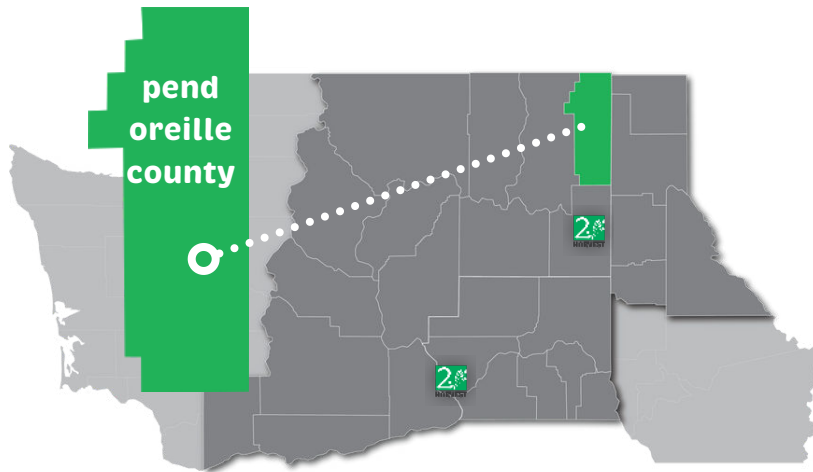
how you help
