Serene attended her first Mobile Market free food distribution in Medical Lake two weeks ago. She returned for today's Mobile Market because she has more mouths to feed than she did before the Grays Fire, and food prices aren't decreasing.

Three of Serene's family members, including her daughter and her brother, moved in with her after they were displaced by the wildfire that burned part of the town of Medical Lake a few weeks ago.

"We went from one person in the house to four, with the fire," Serene says. "Two houses, gone."

"It's been a little tough," she says of feeding her newly expanded household. Fresh produce is especially desirable, Serene says.

Apples and corn are among the fresh produce she'll receive today, as well as shelf-stable items such as rice.
